Hint: Start at 1st Street and work your way down to 6th Street; all of the clues follow this order.

- 1. At the end of the street stands a man brave and tall. What year did this guy lead the start of it all? **_1732**_
- 2. This is the oldest standing building on Main Street! It was once a grocery store, and then a bar and tavern many times over, but has recently been restored to its original glory. What building am I? The Burtch & Hannah Grocery building at 104 Main Street
- 3. The building that Elements is currently located in was originally designed and used by architects Thomas Campbell and Louis Osterhage. As a way to help their clients visualize design options, the architects used *10* different styles of windows on the façade of their building.
- 4. Known as Vincennes' first "sky-scraper," this building was the tallest in town until the American National Bank building was constructed. What building am I?

 The J.T. Oliphant Building at 214 Main Street

- 5. You won't find this building may have the façade of a Corinthian temple, but it is far from being in Greece. It did, however, used to be home to items that were worthy of the gods. What building am I? 217 Main Street, formerly Jewel Craft Jewelers
- 6. The doc's in this building will help you see the view, but how many pairs of stone eyes now peer right down at you? 13 pairs. The location is *Eyeworks* [223 Main Street]
- 7. You're guaranteed to have a great thyme and meal here! What restaurant am I? *Old Thyme Diner*
- 8. From rock and roll, to songs that will soothe your soul—this place has it all. What business am I? **Record Cellar**
- 9. Look up at this building above the second arch. Do you see the shield that sets them apart? They may not be knights that wear armor to protect you, but they do wear suits in a courtroom. What business am I? *HartBell Attorneys* at 513 Main Street
- 10. They may not show movies here anymore, but they do still sell snacks! Get a picture in front of this building's marquee sign. *Old Chicago Pizza & Tap Room*
